



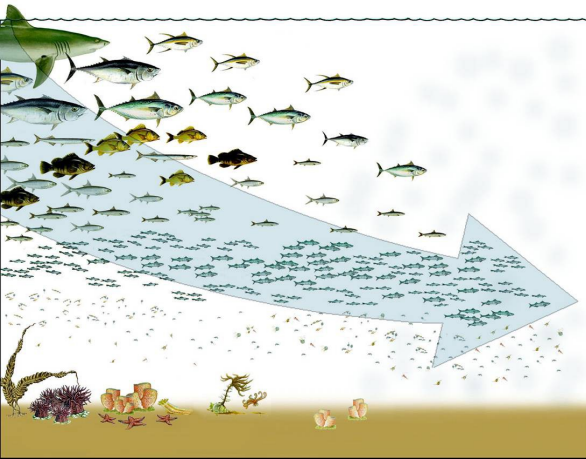
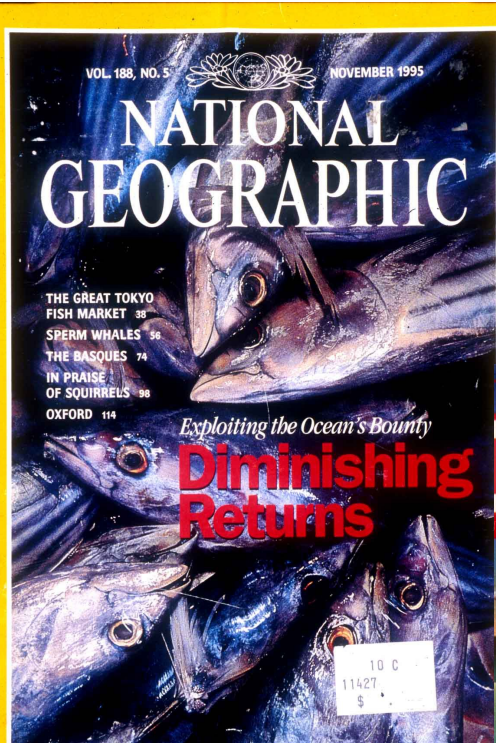

Challenges to Ocean Health



Levers and Learning Journeys



Analysing the big challenges to the ocean, we **collectively** extracted what we considered “levers” enabling action for positive change.

In order to discover new angles to “old problems” we went on learning journeys. They enabled us to find additional ways for acting on the levers identified.



Learning & building on the RT

- In addition to excellent science publications, we need to tell stories and connect also emotionally to the public; we call it **critically engaged science**
- We need to support widespread public engagement for effective policies;
- We need **Everybody** to bring about the change at the required scale.



What have we done since?

- Rashid Sumaila and his group's work on subsidies supported the **Global Ocean Commission** of senior politicians and business leaders in developing their 8 concrete recommendations to rescue the ocean.
- In a great group effort, **Beau Dick's** speech at the Copper breaking ceremony in Victoria was transformed into a poem by Francisco Alarcon and made into the video "We are all connected" by Dana Miller. PWIAS RT website.

What else have we done?

- Paolo Dini of the London School of Economics developed his proposal for **community currencies** for non-capitalist markets further. That could help to revive economies empirical research in Sardinia, Italy, suggests.
- Aylin Ulman has developed **advisories** for responsible behaviour towards the ocean for different user groups .



Just two more examples

- Cornelia Nauen is coordinating the group of editors and contributors towards the book about the RT – it's going to be **open access** and host also inputs from people who wanted to be there but couldn't join.
- Rashid Sumaila is using approaches of the RT in the **Ocean Canada project** he coordinates, particularly in relation to work with First Nations.
