Participants:

Students, pupils, individually or as a group

Media:

- a) Photography (preferably prints; alternatively: digital files on CD Rom or USB-stick)
- b) Paintings
- c) Graphical works

Size of the works to be submitted:

Preferably DIN A2 (420 x 594 mm/16,54 x 23.39 Inches) or DIN A3 (297 x 420 mm/11.69 x 16,54 Inches) – bigger sizes can not be admitted

Quantities:

The number of submitted original pieces should be maximum three per individual and maximum 10 per group. Exhibition of submitted pieces is not guaranteed. Consideration is, however, ensured for each participant and each group.

Themes (see supplement):

1. The Beauty of the Sea

All pictures created around this subject are welcome, be they creative colourful paintings, graphics and/or photography.

2. Stories of the sea

Stories and myths of the sea (particularly from your specific region) should be expressed visually.

Please add a write-up of the story as a text document and send by email.

3. Posters about the threats to the integrity of the sea

Posters with an advocacy character about the topic „Our Threatened Seas“ should draw attention to the threats and invite action towards change for the better (preferably with appeal about what can be done concretely to help). Posters may be composed manually or with digital means.

Attention:

Participants should look at how youth groups are already presenting themselves on the webpage of *Mundus maris* (<http://www.mundusmaris.org/index.php/en/youthnetwork>). To present themselves, they can use the available template for sharing some key information about their group (including some photos of their school and surroundings) and should provide contact details. Please the self-presentation to info@mundusmaris.org (mention SeaArt Hilden 2011). Participants should also add some explanatory text (preferably also in digital form) about the works when they submit these. We offer to give them visibility through the website.
